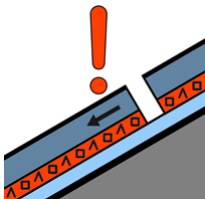

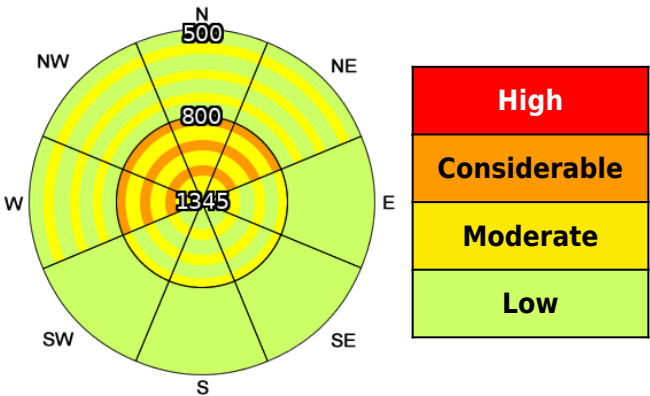
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will be very variable in nature, however localised instabilities will be present especially on West through North to North-East aspects above 800 metres. Elsewhere snowpack stability will be generally good. Snow at lower altitudes will start to thaw. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry with generally moderate Easterly winds over the summits. The freezing level will gradually rise to above the summits through the day.
