
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. Variably stability will persist in the snowpack, with weak windslab on steepest West to North-West aspects above 900 metres. Localised instabilities will also remain on North to North-East aspects in steep, sheltered gully flanks. Most affected areas will be the top of coire back walls and gully exits above 900 metres. Good stability on many wind scoured slopes and ridges. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable
