



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 14/02/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change expected with the snowline around 550 metres and many summit areas remaining bare. The general snow cover is thin and stable. There is some depth to the snowpack in very localised areas namely gully exits and corrie rims above 700 metres on North-West through to Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Continuing Easterly winds, although easing during the day. It will be freezing overnight with the temperature rising to above the summits during the day.

Comments

Another sunny day but feeling cold in the fresh Easterly winds.
