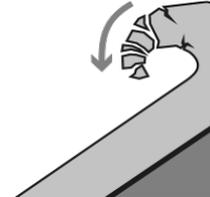



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will consolidate further in the milder conditions and will be generally well bonded in most areas, some residual instabilities will persist at depth but these will be confined to deeper accumulations above 950 metres on West to North aspects, mainly in steep and convex terrain around corrie rims. Elsewhere stability will be generally good with many areas scoured and bare. Cornices will be unstable and liable to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry for the forecast period. Winds will be moderate to strong Southerly. Freezing level will be around summit levels.
