



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 15/02/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change expected. The general snow cover is thin and stable with many summits remaining bare. There are some localised areas of snow depth, namely on corrie rims and gully exits above 700 metres on North-West through to Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Wind slowly increasing in strength from a South-South-East direction during the day with little precipitation. The freezing level dropping to around the summits by dawn and slightly increasing during the day.
