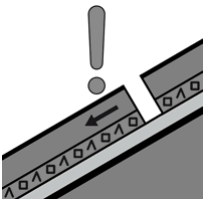


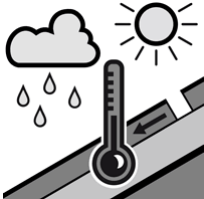

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 15/02/2017

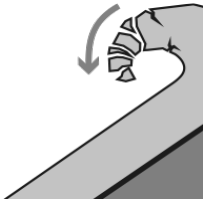

Persistent Weak Layers



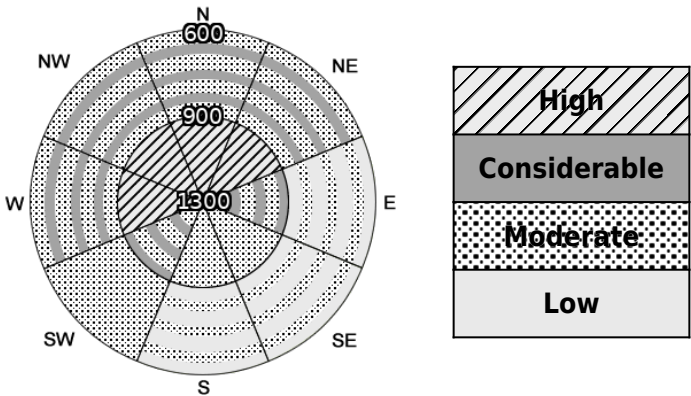

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain variable in nature, both in distribution and composition. Moderately bonded windslab will be present in wind sheltered areas on many aspects; West to North aspects above 800 metres will be most affected. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be a dry day, though some light rain is possible overnight and during the afternoon. Moderate South-East winds will increase in strength and veer South-South-Easterly during the morning. The freezing level will be around or just above the higher summits.
