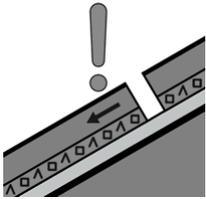


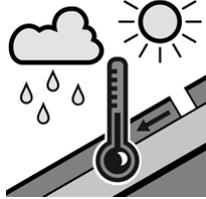

#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 16/02/2017

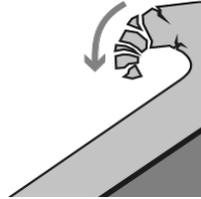

Persistent Weak Layers





##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will deplete in extent and be moist, but will generally be stable throughout. Some moderately stable areas will be present in the deeper deposits but these will be confined to steep and convex locations on West to North aspects above 950 metres. Any new snow will be confined to the higher summits and will not be significant. Cornices above Northerly aspects will be liable to collapse affecting slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing levels will be around summit level. Precipitation will fall as sleet or snow on the summits rain below. Winds will be strong South-Westerly veering Westerly in the afternoon.
