


### THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 18/02/2017

##### Avalanche Problems

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy and depleted snowpack will continue to thaw at all levels and will remain stable and well bonded. Most remnants of snow will lie on steep slopes, North to East aspects above 750 metres, and will be firmer at higher elevations. Many hillsides and summits will remain bare. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

It will continue mild with heavy early morning rain at all levels turning showery through the day. The fresh to strong South-South-East wind will gradually veer West-South-West by the end of the period. The freezing level will remain above the summits, although perhaps cold enough at the end of the day for a dusting of new snow on the highest tops.
