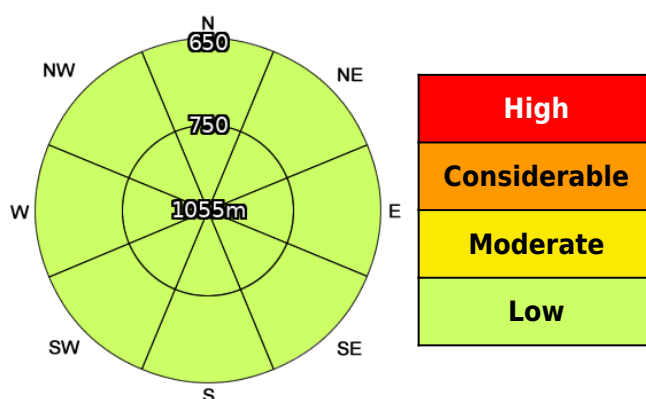


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 19/02/2017****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Fresh overnight wet snow on the highest summits will thaw during the day. Otherwise, the existing patchy much depleted and diminishing snowpack will remain well bonded. Most patches and strips of snow on North to East aspects above 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Rain and sleet showers will die out overnight to give a cloudy day with rain in the afternoon at all levels, intensifying by the end of the day. The freezing level will rise well above the summits through the day and a fresh South-West wind will gradually strengthen.

Comments

At higher elevations, the snow is more firm. The ground is saturated.
