


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 20/02/2017


#### Avalanche Problems



Cornices

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Initially the snowpack will continue to diminish in all areas. As it turns cooler it will become firmer at higher levels and remain generally well bonded and stable throughout. Remaining cornices which overhang Northerly aspects will be unstable especially during the spell of rain. The avalanche hazard will be Low



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight there will be some light rain at all levels, this is expected to die out by mid morning. Westerly winds will be strong to gale force. Turning cooler through the afternoon as the freezing level falls from summit levels to 800 metres by the end of the day.

#### Comments

A brief cold spell on Monday evening, mild on Tuesday, turning cold again on Wednesday with North winds.
