
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy snowpack will remain moist but well-stabilised. Colder conditions during the day will make surface layers firm and more tightly bonded. Very little new snow is expected. Falling ice will remain a consideration. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Mild with rain dying out during the day. Becoming colder by midday with a little light snowfall. Strong Westerly winds.

Comments

Falling ice and rocks from the Post Face and Inner Coire crags will remain a consideration.
