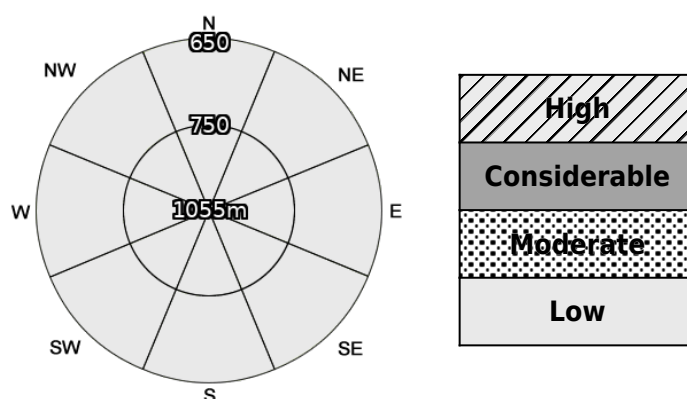

The very limited snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and will remain stable. Most patches exist above 750 metres on North to Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Westerly winds remaining strong before backing South-Westerly and strengthening to gale force by tomorrow afternoon as freezing levels rise to above the summits. Continuing showery with a dusting of snow on the highest summits overnight and becoming very wet by tomorrow afternoon.

Comments

The vast majority of hillsides are bare. Remaining windy and wet.
