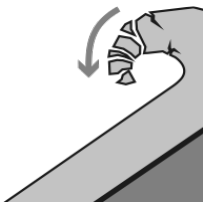

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 21/02/2017

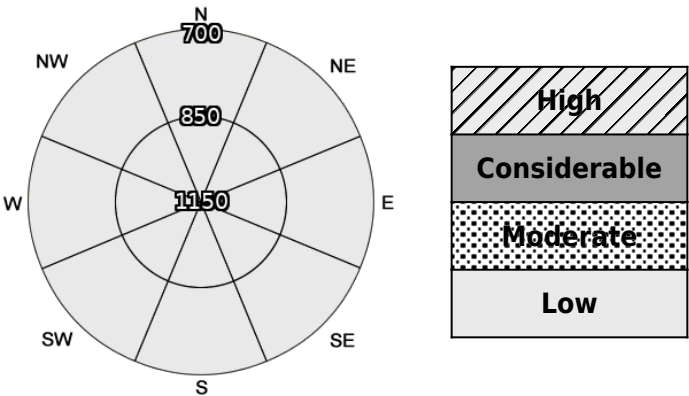
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moist snowpack will consolidate in the colder temperatures. New snow amounts are not expected to be significant or extensive only a dusting and short lived. Snowpack stability will generally be good in all locations.
The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will fall to 900 metres with some isolated showers falling as light snow above 800 metres. During the morning the freezing level rising again to above the summits with rain becoming established in the afternoon. Strong Westerly winds will ease then back to South-West and strengthen.
