
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited snowpack that exists on mostly North-West to Easterly facing slopes above 950 metres will be well bonded and stable. Some new accumulations of new snow will form on North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 350 metres or so, but these accumulations are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be very strong sometimes storm force Westerly throughout the forecast period. Precipitation in the evening and overnight will fall as sleet or light snow at summit levels. During the day as the freezing level lowers to 600 metres, light snow showers are expected.

Comments

Colder conditions with some light snow expected.
