### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 22/02/2017


#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The older broken snow cover will be firm and well bonded. Isolated surface instabilities will develop only on steep and very sheltered features but these deposits are not expected to achieve much depth and will be avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

A return to Wintry conditions. It will cool overnight with rain turning to light snowfall from around 400 metres. Gale force winds will initially be from the West but veering to the West-North-West in the afternoon.

#### Comments

Likely to be a poor day on the hill Wednesday, with snow showers and gale force winds forecast.
