

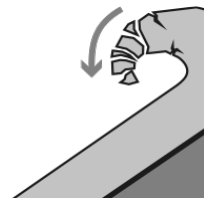

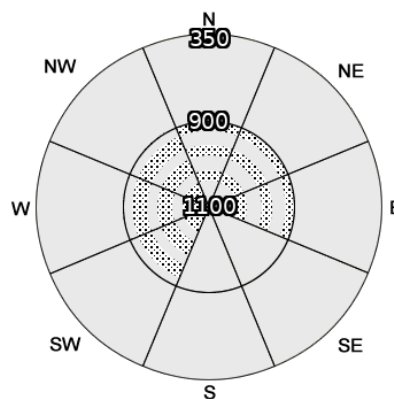
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations of marginally stabilised windslab will persist on some very sheltered North to East aspects above 900 metres. New windslab development expected on some very steep South-West through West to North- West aspects above 900 metres. Scoured, old and exposed snowpack will remain hard and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Fairly low impact effects expected from Winter Storm Doris. Westerly winds will ease dramatically overnight becoming moderate Easterly before dawn, later North- Easterly. Some snow showers from the early hours until mid-morning. Remaining cold throughout.
