
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will continue to consolidate in the cooler temperatures. Localised windslab accumulations will develop during the day on North-West through North to East aspects above 950 metres. Areas most affected will be around corrie rims and gully tops. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight with some light snowfall through the day, this may turn to sleet for a short spell during the afternoon. Winds will be South-South-Westerly moderate increasing strong to gale force, gradually decreasing through the day. The freezing level will be around 800 to 900 metres.
