


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

#### Avalanche Problems




Wind Slab

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Initially unstable windslab will persist around coire rims gully exits and crag aprons on North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Through the course of the day some redistribution of snow with localised unstable windslab developing on steep sheltered South-East to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Other aspects will be affected due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



#### Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry throughout the forecast period with moderate Westerly winds veering to the North-North-West, increasing moderate to strong through the afternoon. The freezing level will rise from 400 to 600 metres.

#### Comments

Vertical banks of windslab at the top of some easy grade North facing gullies.
