

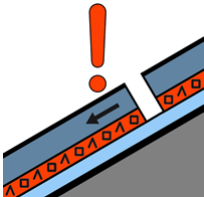

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 01/03/2017

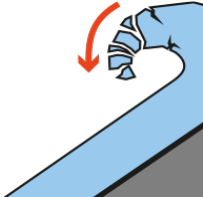
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



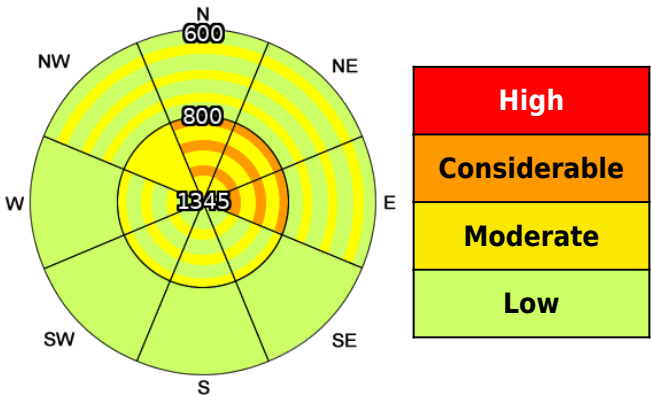
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected in the snowpack. Areas of unstable windslab will remain on mainly North to East aspects above 800 metres. Other aspects will hold a few pockets of windslab in sheltered locations, but will generally be scoured and hold little snow. Some fragile cornices will remain. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold, with moderate North-Westerly winds backing to the West. The freezing level will be around 500 metres. There may be a few light snow showers.

Expected to remain relatively cold and settled for a few days. Winter has finally arrived : )
