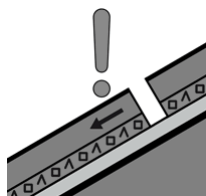
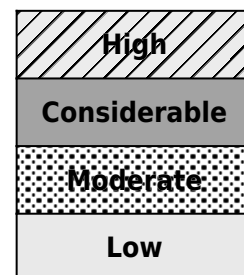
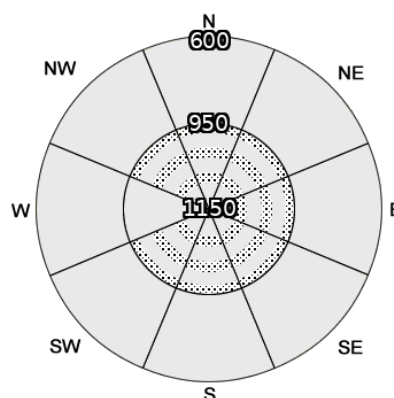

Some redistribution of available deposits is expected in the strong winds. Localised areas of moderately bonded windslab will be present on North-West through East to South-West aspects above 950 metres. Distribution of such deposits will not be extensive and will mainly be limited to steeper, sheltered locations such as gully exits and corrie rims. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be another cold, dry and partially cloudy day. The strong North-North-Westerly overnight winds will ease to fresh and back to the West. The freezing level will fluctuate between 400 and 600 metres.
