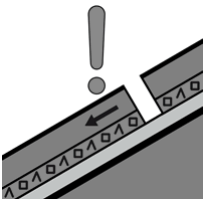


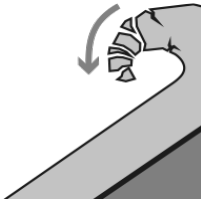

Avalanche Problems



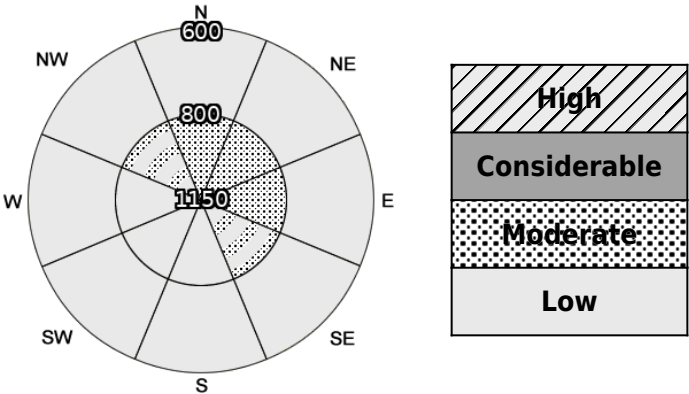
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Deposits of generally moderately bonded windslab will persist in sheltered areas, mainly on North to East aspects above 800 metres. Greatest instabilities will be in the tops of gullies and around corrie rims. Other areas will be refrozen or wind scoured. Cornices will remain fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be generally dry throughout the period. The freezing level will be around 400 metres, rising slightly through the day. The fresh Westerly wind will ease slightly.

Comments

Cold, generally dry and bright weather expected mid week.
