

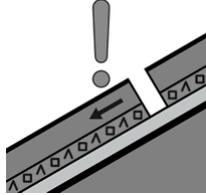

Avalanche Problems




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will mainly be well bonded and stable. Localised areas of moderately bonded windslab will be present on North through East to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Greatest amounts will be found in gully exits and around corrie rims. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold with a dusting of overnight snow, dry thereafter. Moderate winds will initially be from the North-West but backing Westerly by the end of the day.

Comments

Some gully exits will require care.
