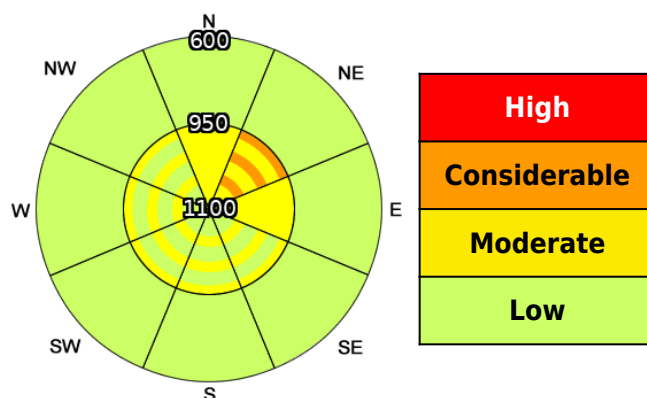
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weakness will persist in what is a generally shallow snowpack, with localised instabilities on many aspects above 950m. Older deposits of firmer windslab are in steepest, sheltered and shaded North to North Easterly aspects, with some softer, more recent localised pockets of slab build-up on sheltered South West through South to East aspects. Good stability on all wind-exposed locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold and mostly dry, with some snow showers later in the day. The light to fresh winds West North West will become Westerly overnight.
