

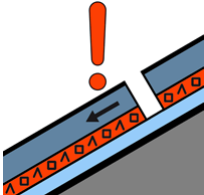

Avalanche Problems



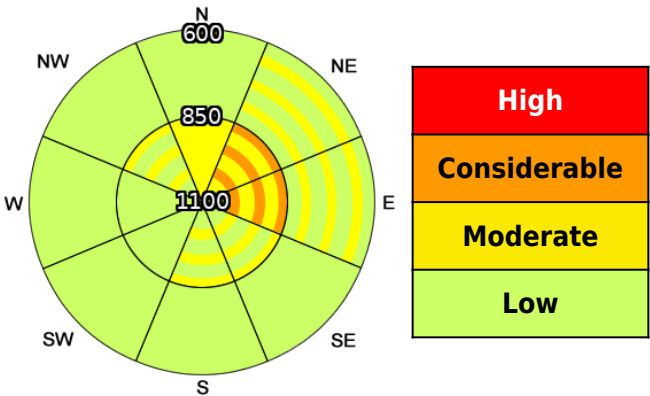
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised weakness will exist in shaded North to East aspects above 850 metres. Some new moderately bonded localised accumulations are also possible, primarily on Easterly aspects, although some cross-loading is also possible in other steepest gully flanks and exits. Elsewhere any small pockets of windslab on other aspects will be small and in the main easily avoided. Good stability on all wind-exposed locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold overnight with freezing levels rising slightly during the day to around 500 metres. Some light snow showers are forecast during the day accompanied by freshening Westerly winds.
