

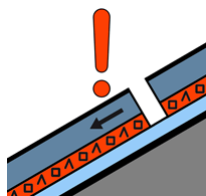

Wind Slab



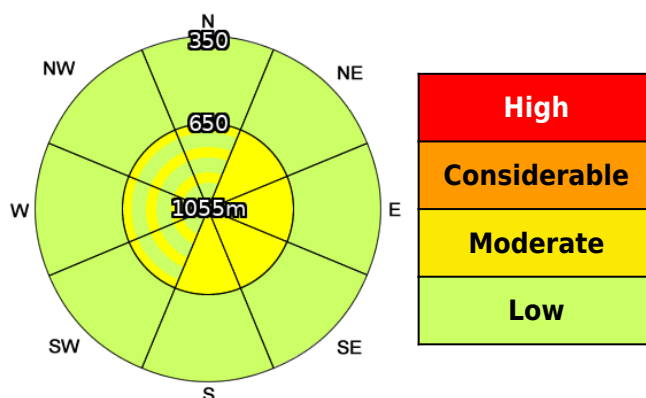
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

At first wind slab and cornices will continue to build on North-East through East to South aspects above 650 metres with further cross loading in other areas. Existing underlying weaknesses in the snow pack will remain on all aspects above 750 metres especially on gully exits and wind shelters terrain where poorly bonded depositions will have developed further. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A light snow shower this evening then a relatively settled dry spell with lighter winds is expected. Strong West- South-West winds will weaken overnight becoming variable moderate East-North-Easterly tomorrow. The freezing level will hover around 550 metres.
