

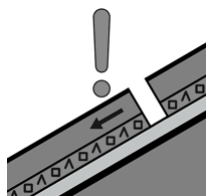

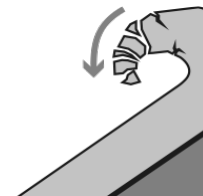

Wind Slab



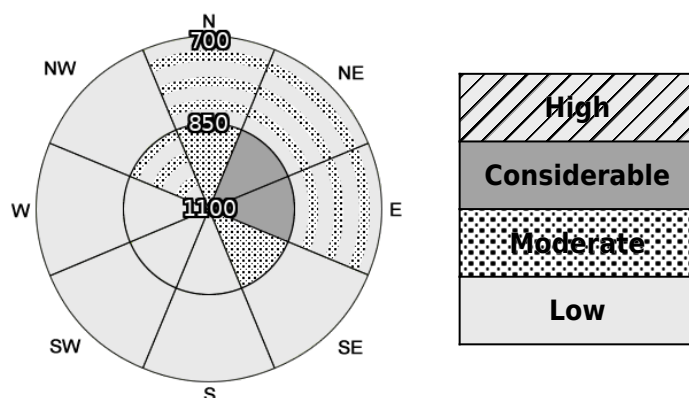
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Additional weak windslab will build overnight mainly on steep North-East to East aspects above 850m. Cross-loading will have affected the flanks and exit ramps of gullies on other aspects, too. Instability will persist in all these locations throughout the day. New weak cornices will be in place over most recent lee slopes. Better stability on ridges and slopes exposed to recent scouring. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers for a time overnight then dry for the rest of the period. West-South-West winds initially strong but falling light and variable during the early hours. Very cold overnight but temperatures easing a little during the day.
