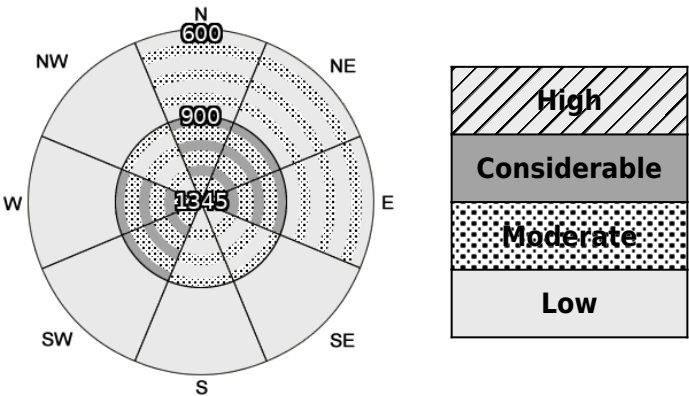

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will persist mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Fragile cornices above these aspects will be prone to collapse. Fresh snow and redistribution will deposit fresh unstable windslab in steep, sheltered locations mainly on South-West and West aspects above 900 metres with other aspects affected by cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate to strong East-North-Easterly winds. Dry overnight then snow showers. Freezing level around 700 metres.
