



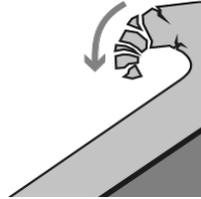

Wind Slab




Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a redistribution of snow with poor to weakly bonded windslab developing on North-West through North to East aspects mainly above 1000 metres. Coire rims, gully exits and steep sheltered terrain will be mostly affected. Instabilities on other aspects due to cross loading. Localised windslab on steep sheltered banks below this level. Cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Generally dry with the possibility of a snow shower. Light Southerly winds will increase moderate to strong through the day and veer to the South-West. The freezing level will be around 900 metres.

A lot of snow on the plateau for redistribution.
