

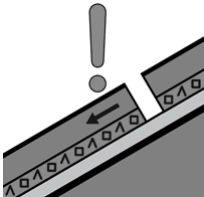

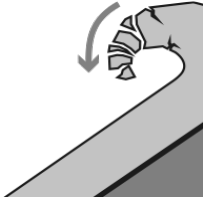
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



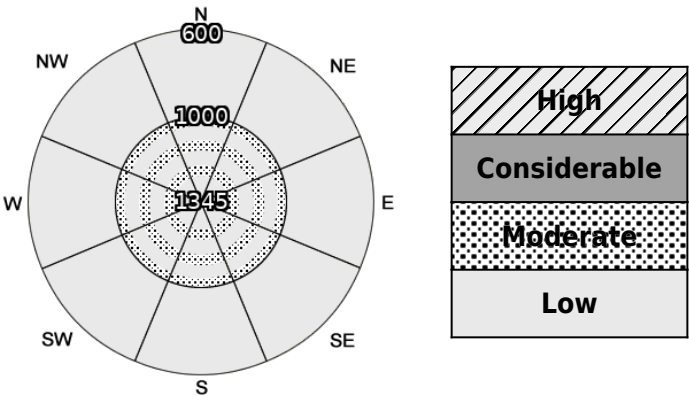
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of moderately bonded windslab will persist on all aspects above 1000 metres with greatest accumulations on North to East aspects. Fragile cornices will be present above these aspects. During the afternoon redistribution will cause some fresh unstable windslab to be deposited on North-West to North-East aspects above 1000 metres. At lower elevations the snowpack will consolidate in the colder temperatures and become generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light to moderate Southerly wind increasing through the afternoon. Mostly dry with occasional snow showers possible. Freezing level around 700 metres.
