

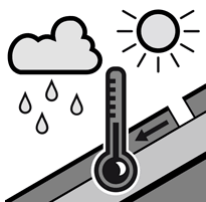

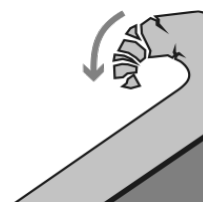

Wind Slab



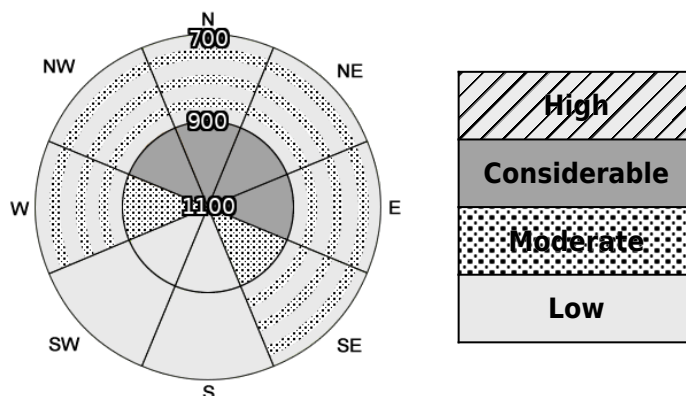

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Marginally stabilised windslab will gain depth and become more widespread on all steep North-West through North to East aspects above 900m. New weak cornice development expected above steepest lee slopes. The snowpack below 850m will be moist and only moderately stabilised on steeper slopes of many aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers throughout with rain at lower altitudes. Strong South-East, then South later South-Westerly winds. Freezing level around 900m.
