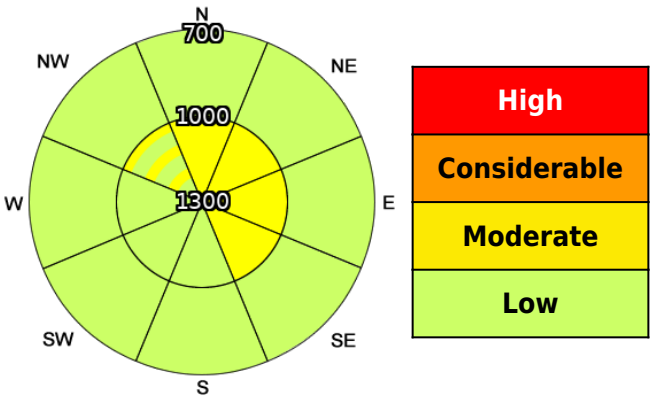

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate and will be generally stable on all aspects and at all levels. Some instabilities will persist however, especially in areas of deeper accumulation above 1000 metres on North through East to South-East aspects. Steep and convex shaped terrain and rolls high in coire headwalls and around coire rims will be especially affected. Cornices will be liable to collapse onto slopes below as temperatures rise. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Light West-North-West winds at first will back Southerly in the early hours, strengthening in the day to strong. Generally dry throughout the forecast period but with the occasional snow-shower in the morning. Freezing levels around 900 metres at first will rise to well above the summits through the day.
