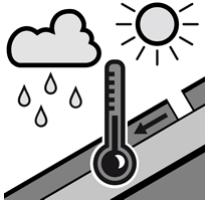


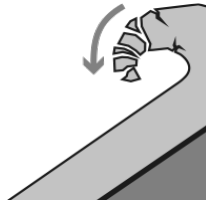

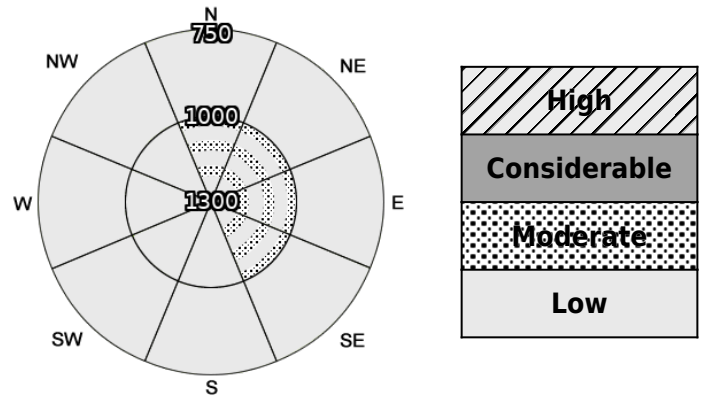

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw at all altitudes and be generally stable in most areas. Instabilities will persist in isolated steep locations on North through East to South-East aspects above 1000 metres. Areas most affected will be around convexities and coire rims. Cornices will remain unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Mostly dry and mild with some light precipitation expected during the afternoon, this will fall as sleet and snow at summit levels. Light Southerly winds will increase to moderate and veer to the West. Cooler during the afternoon with freezing levels falling to 1100 metres.

Comments

Cornice collapse and rockfall continue to be a potential hazard during the mild conditions.
