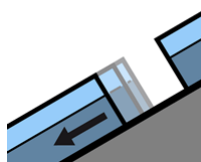

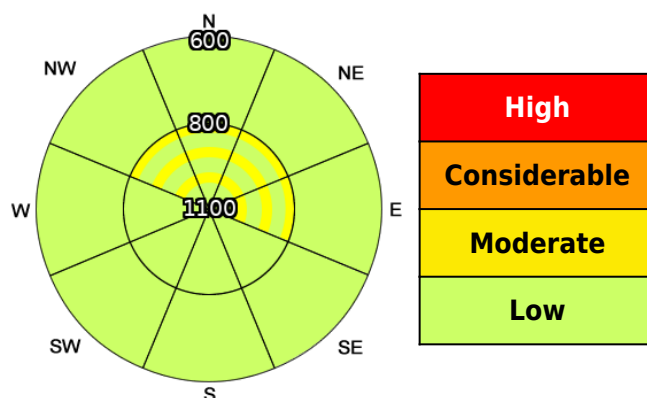

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further consolidation of the old snowpack expected especially above 950 metres as temperatures fall. Localised wet snow instability mainly on very steeply inclined benches and ledges of North-East to East facing crags below 950 metres. Additional cornice collapse potential will persist before the onset of cooler temperatures later. Very limited new snow amounts expected to bring little or no additional hazard. Falling ice and rocks also possible. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming progressively cooler. Dry overnight; a little light snowfall is possible near summits after midday. Moderate South-West winds later in the day.

Comments

Some potential for minor full depth avalanches on the crags of the Post Face and Inner Coire.
