



#### Avalanche Problems




Wet Snow

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Surface instabilities possible within steep terrain overnight before the snowpack becomes firmer through the day above 900 metres. In general the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable in all locations. Isolated pockets of windslab may develop in sheltered areas on Easterly aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Strong to gale force South-West veering Westerly winds with light rain at all levels through the night. During the day the freezing level will fall to around 900 metres with sleet turning to light snow flurries through the afternoon.

A brief cool period, turning mild again later on Wednesday
