





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some localised, minor full depth avalanche potential will persist mainly on the very steep North-East and East facing crags above 800 metres in Coire Ardair, specifically the Post Face and Inner Coire. During the day fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be very strong South-Westerly veering Westerly. Light rain is expected at all levels overnight with the freezing level well above the summits. By dawn the freezing level will have dropped to around 900 metres and during the day light showers will fall as snow above around 700 metres.
