


**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 16/03/2017**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The depleted and patchy snowpack will remain stable and well bonded throughout the period and will continue to thaw at all levels overnight. A dusting of fresh snow will settle above 500 metres on all aspects by the end of the day with perhaps some localised accumulations on North-East to East aspects above 800 metres. However, amounts will be insignificant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will increasingly be a dusting of fresh summit snow after daybreak when patchy light overnight rain turns wintry as the freezing level lowers to 500 metres by the end of the period. The strong South-West wind will strengthen for a time overnight before easing through the day, veering Westerly.
