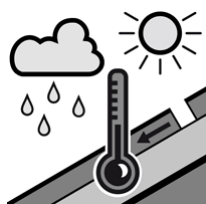
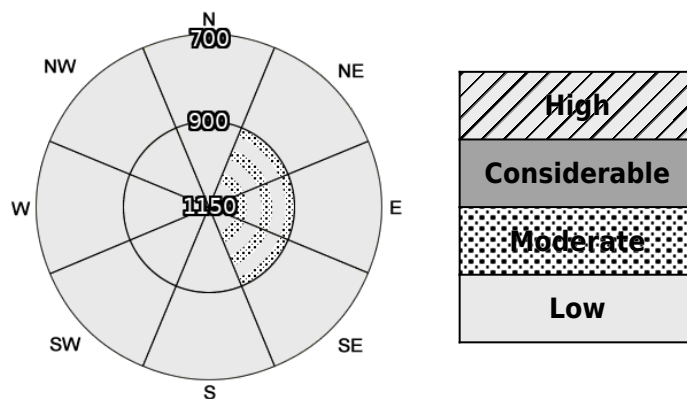


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 19/03/2017****Avalanche Problems****Wet Snow****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be a period of instability overnight. By morning the snow cover will be soft but generally well bonded in most locations. Localised instabilities will persist on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Greatest hazard will be on steep gully exits and around corrie rims. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight, the freezing level will be above the summits with rain at all levels. It will become a mainly dry day with the freezing level dropping to around 1000 metres at the end of the afternoon. There will be strong winds from the West throughout the day.

Comments

Rain overnight but mainly a dry but windy day forecast.
