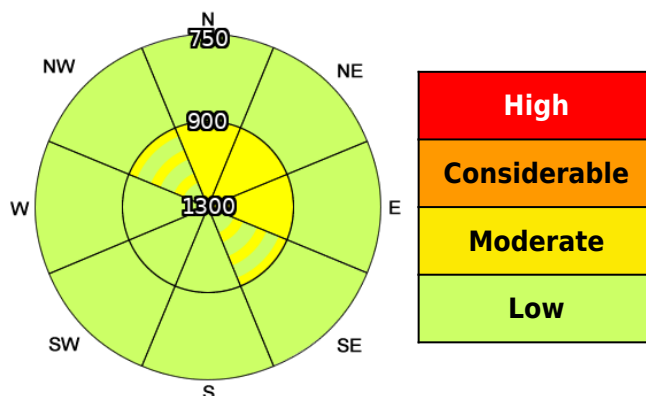

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will consolidate and become much firmer. New accumulations of windslab will develop on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Deeper deposits will be moderate to poorly bonded especially around steep sheltered areas such as coire rims gully exits and below convexities. More localised windslab will form on North-West and South-East aspects due to cross loading. New cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers are expected through the day on strong to gale force South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will fall to 600 metres.
