





**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Areas of windslab will continue to build and some cross loading can be expected with continued cornice development. Corrie rims, gully tops and wind sheltered steep terrain on North through East to South-East aspects above 750 metres will be particularly affected. South to West aspects will generally be wind scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

A cold showery airflow will cover the Scottish mountains. Gale force winds will reduce in strength slightly becoming strong South-Westerly. The freezing level will lower from 500 metres to around 400 metres. Moderate snow showers are expected throughout the period.
