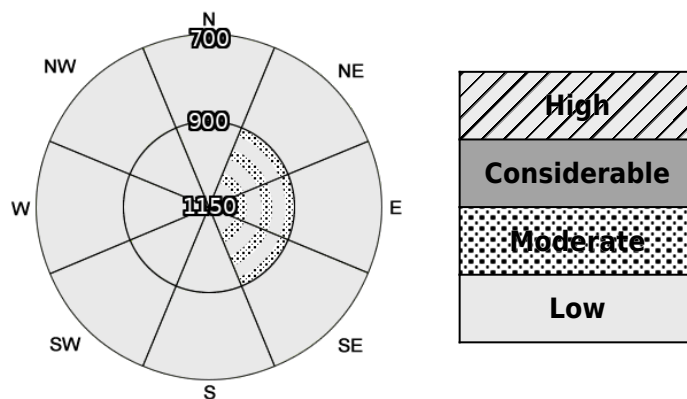


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 21/03/2017****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The patchy firm snow cover will be well bonded and stable. Localised areas of windslab will develop in sheltered locations on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. New deposits will generally be shallow and of little consequence but where they do acquire depth they will be moderately bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Remaining cold with light snowfall down to lower levels throughout the period. Strong winds will be from the West-South-West.
