




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of windslab will continue to develop on very sheltered mainly North to East aspects above 800m; where deposits achieve depth and particularly in steepest gully flanks and exits, accumulations will be poor to moderately well bonded. Good stability on all scoured windward slopes and ridgelines. Fragile cornices will continue to develop at the top of very steep lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and during the day a cold showery airflow will continue to bring further snow showers, at times to all levels; with freezing levels lowering to around 200m. The winds will be very strong West-South Westerly throughout.

Comments

Due to the very showery nature of precipitation medium confidence only at best in forecast quantities of snow over the period.
