

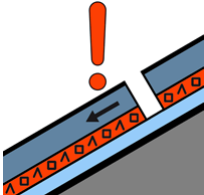

Avalanche Problems



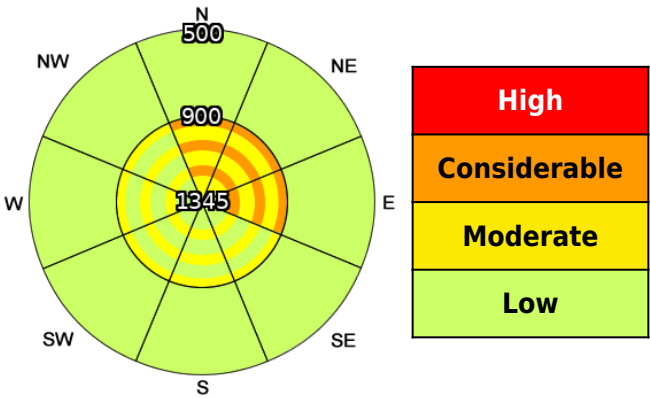
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snow at lower elevations will start to slowly thaw. Above 900m, localised areas of unstable snow will be present on many steep aspects. Greatest accumulations will be on North, North-East and East facing slopes and gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

North-Easterly winds will decrease during the morning. The freezing level will rise to around 900m. No precipitation is expected.
