



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow pack will continue to consolidate at all elevations. Some wet snow instabilities will exist particularly with rising daytime temperatures and on sun affected, mainly South-Easterly aspects above 850 metres. Some localised instabilities will persist above 950 metres in heavily shaded North to Easterly aspects. Cornices will be unstable and be increasingly prone to collapse as the daytime temperature increases. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure will maintain dry and settled conditions. Cool overnight temperatures with air and freezing levels rising to well above summits during the day; clear skies and sunshine expected. The winds will be moderate West-South-Westerly easing Westerly during the day.
