

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 26/03/2017


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The depleted snowpack will be generally well bonded with reasonable cover remaining above 800 metres. Most significant snow accumulations will be on steep slopes, North through East to South-East aspects. Sun affected snow will soften through the day but will remain firm in the shade. Many South to West facing slopes and some summit ridges will be bare. Remaining unstable cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Little change is expected with high pressure dominating. It will be a warm, dry and sunny day with a light generally Southerly breeze.
