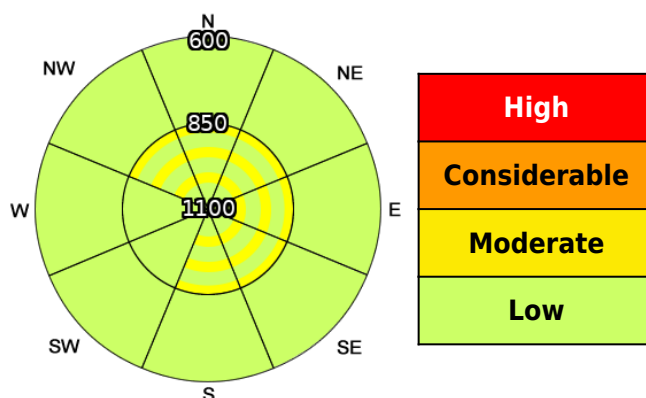

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack continues to consolidate at all levels as the slow thaw continues. With rise in daytime temperatures wet snow instabilities will exist on many steep sheltered aspects above 850 meters. Easterly to South facing slopes will be most affected. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. Falling ice and rocks are also possible. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Little change as high pressure stays centred over Scotland. South-Westerly winds easing, becoming light and Easterly in direction with freezing levels remaining above the summits.

Great weather to be out and about. Snow level a bit too high for ski touring unless you are very keen.
