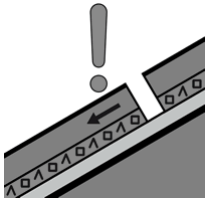


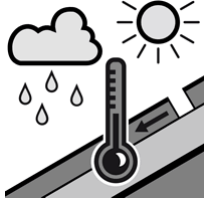

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 26/03/2017

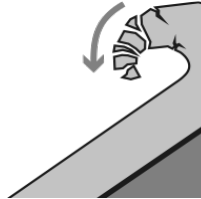

Persistent Weak Layers



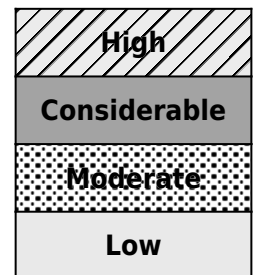
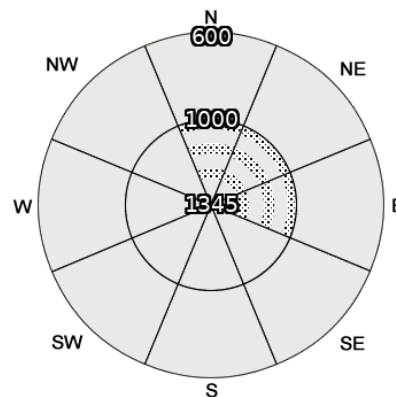

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will slowly consolidate and stabilise on all aspects. Localised moderate instabilities will persist in deeper accumulations mainly on North to East aspects above 1000 metres. Wet snow surface instabilities will be present on slopes exposed to the sun. Cornice collapse and ice fall from steep ground will be additional hazards. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry and clear with light variable winds. Freezing level will be well above the summits.
