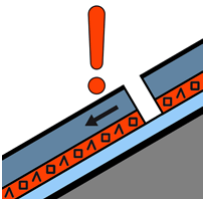

Persistent Weak Layers



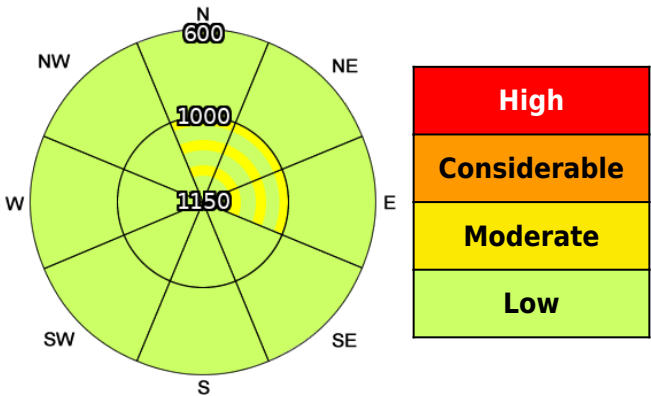

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate and will be generally stable. Localised deposits of moderately bonded windslab will persist, mainly on North to East aspects above 1000 metres, particularly affected will be steep gullies and corrie rims. Wet snow surface instabilities will be present on slopes exposed to the sun. There is potential for rock and ice fall on steep ground as temperatures rise and cornices are liable to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate winds from a generally South-Easterly direction easing slightly through the day. Remaining dry throughout the period with the freezing level above the summits.
