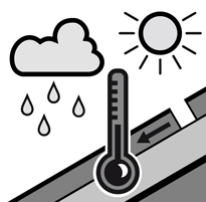
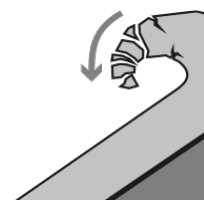
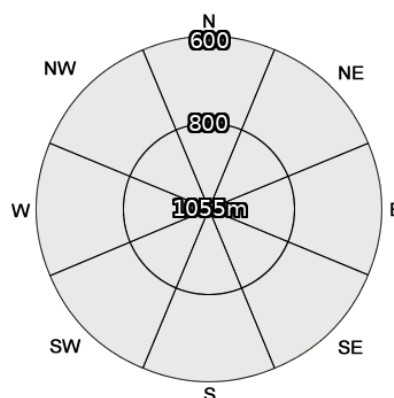

The depleting snow pack which is mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres will continue to consolidate and is generally well bonded. Some wet snow instabilities will be present on steep slopes as the snow surface thaws. The avalanche hazard will be Low

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Winds will remain light for most of the period, become variable and will rise to moderate South-Easterly by tomorrow afternoon. The freezing level will remain above the summits with no precipitation forecast.
