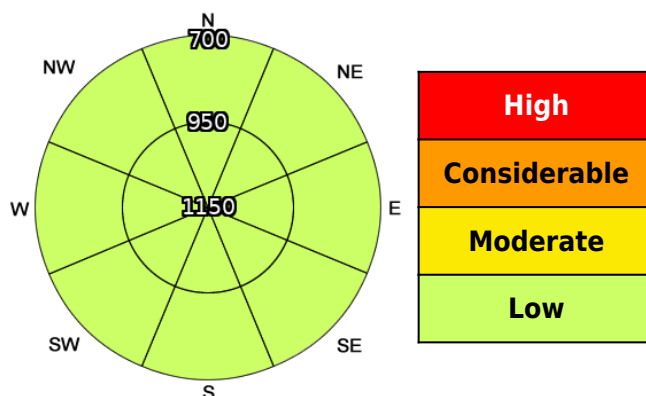

The patchy snow cover will continue to thaw but remain stable. Falling rocks will remain a hazard on steep terrain. Greatest amounts of snow will be found on North to East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A cloudy and mild day with the freezing levels above the summits. Winds will strengthen from the South to become moderate in strength throughout the day.
