
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack with greatest accumulations on North-East to South-East aspects above 950 metres continues to diminish in extent but although soft in the surface layers stability will be good throughout. Some surface instabilities are possible on the steepest slopes and rockfall will be a hazard below crags. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Light South-West winds backing during the day and becoming strong South-South-Easterly. Freezing level above the summits throughout the period. Mainly dry but with precipitation falling as rain to all levels from mid- afternoon.

Comments

The recent sunny days are coming to an end with some rain expected later in the day.
